CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

The Organising Committee of ICIIC 2007 invites the submission of abstracts for **either oral or poster presentation.**

(Please ensure that you specify which format you prefer).

The Committee invites abstracts on **all** aspects of infection in the immunocompromised child. A list of topics is given below, as a guide. Case reports are also encouraged. We are able to offer a limited number of free paper presentations and a large capacity for poster presentations. All accepted abstracts will be published in the Conference Programme and Abstract Book.

Free papers and posters present an excellent opportunity to stimulate debate, raise issues or highlight quality work being carried out by teams or individuals. They can be used as a mechanism to reach a wider audience whilst both motivating colleagues and challenging their thinking. Material can be either research or practice-led.

Potential Topics for Abstracts:

- Bacterial Infections • Viral and Rickettsial Infections • Fungal Infections • Protozoan and Helminth Infections
- Prevention/Vaccines • Anti-Infectives • Diagnostic Techniques • Immunomodulatory Therapies

Please take time to read these Submission Guidelines:

- a) Your abstract must be received by 1st September 2007
- b) Your abstract must be submitted in English
- c) Your abstract must not exceed **250 words including references**
- d) You need to clarify how you wish to present the abstract – ie as a poster or an oral presentation
- e) Any potential conflict of interests must be declared
- f) Your abstract must be submitted by E-Mail as an attachment **not as part of the text** in MS Word format to immunoabstracts@indexcommunications.com
- g) Faxed or posted abstracts will not be accepted for submission
- h) The author submitting the abstract is the **Corresponding Author** and this author's contact details must be clearly given (address, tel, fax, e-mail). The name of the author (**Presenting Author**) presenting the paper or discussing the poster must be underlined
- i) Your abstract should be structured according to the following format: Title, Authors (surname and initials) and Affiliations, Abstract, References (Key only, max 5)
- j) The decision of the Abstract Review Committee on the acceptability of the abstract *is final*. While preferences for oral or poster presentations will be considered, the Committee may offer the alternative format. No correspondence on their decision can be initiated by the author(s)
- k) ALL PRESENTING AUTHORS MUST REGISTER AS FULL CONFERENCE DELEGATES – NOT DAY DELEGATES**
- l) All abstracts will be acknowledged. *If you have not had a confirmation of receipt within 14 days of your submission, please contact the Conference Secretariat.*

Call for Abstracts Submission Deadline: 1st September 2007

- Instructions on the duration of oral presentations and the format and size of posters will be given in the **result correspondence** which will reach abstract authors **by 1st October 2007**.
- Details of discounted Registration Fees for Presenting Authors will also be contained in the result correspondence (all presenters must register).
- If an abstract cannot be presented at the Conference, the Secretariat must be notified in writing ahead of the Conference to avoid compromise to the professionalism of the meeting.
